NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. The rules of the Flying Scot Class will apply.
- 1.3. Certain rules may be changed and these changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4. By participating in this regatta, a competitor grants to the organization authority and its sponsors the right to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures, and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

2. Eligibility & Entry

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Flying Scot Class.
- 2.2. Flying Scot Class Association membership is strongly encouraged.

3. Boats/Measurement

- 3.1. Flying Scots will be used
- 3.2. Each competitor will be responsible for their boats being in compliance with the class rules.

4. Schedule of Events

Up to six races are planned

October 11: 09:15-10:15 Registration, check-in, and launching

10:15 Skippers meeting

10:30 Harbor gun, followed by Race 1

October 12: 10:30 Harbor gun, No race will be started after 1300

5. Fees

The entry fee will be \$85 if received by October 2. The entry fee will be \$110 if received after October 2. See form below.

The fee includes Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner on Saturday, as well as Breakfast and Lunch Sunday.

6. Housing - Some housing will be available on a first come, first served basis.

7. Sailing Instructions . The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

6. Scoring . A maximum of six (6) races are scheduled, of which one (1) shall be completed to constitute a series. If six races are completed, one score will be excluded from the final results.

7. Prizes . Awards will be given to competitors placing first through fifth in championship division and first in challenger division. The district champion will be the highest finisher in the championship division who is both:

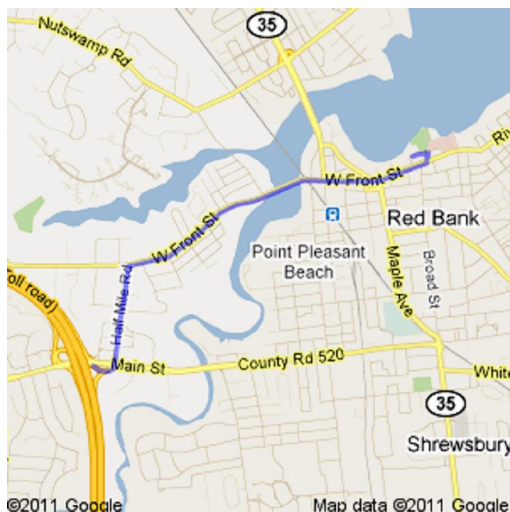
- a member of the Flying Scot Sailing Association
- a member of a fleet in the Greater New York district

The Jack Orr trophy will be awarded to the boat winning the most races.

8. Disclaimer of Liability . Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Directions: Take the Garden State Parkway to Exit 109.



From North: Turn left at traffic light, go under parkway and bear right to make jughandle turn onto Half Mile Road;

From South: Pass directly through the light at the bottom of the ramp (the middle of three options) and straight onto Half Mile Road;

Follow Half Mile Road to end. Turn right onto Front Street, Continue on Front Street, through a light, over water, and then through 5 more lights. Turn left on Wharf Avenue. This is the 1st left after the last light (Broad

Street). Turn left again onto Union Street. Monmouth Boat Club is on the right at the bottom of the hill.
